



WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City of and public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works, "approved June 26, 1941, codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq. (1993), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 48, par. 39s-1 et seq. and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the County Commissioners of the County of Randolph investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of Randolph County employed in performing construction of public works, for said County of Randolph.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RANDOLPH COUNTY:

SECTION 1. To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating the wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the County of Randolph is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in Randolph County are as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June 2016, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the County of Randolph. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of

wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the County of Randolph to extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3. The County of Randolph shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the County of Randolph this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION 4. The County of Randolph shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5. The County of Randolph shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6. The County of Randolph shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.

The following resolution was presented to place a question for a public safety tax on the November 8, 2016 ballot.

RESOLUTION NO. 16-07

RESOLUTION TO PLACE A QUESTION ON THE NOVEMBER 8TH BALLOT FOR A PUBLIC SAFETY TAX

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/5-1006.5 authorizes the county board of any county to impose a tax upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property, other than personal property titled or registered with an agency of this State's government, at retail in the county on the gross receipts from the sales made in the course of business to provide revenue to be used exclusively for public safety in that county, if a proposition for the tax has been submitted to the electors of that county and approved by a majority of those voted on the question.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Tax shall not be applicable to the sales of food for human consumption that is to be consumed off the premises where it is sold (other than alcoholic beverages, soft drinks and food that has been prepared for immediate consumption) and prescription and non-prescription medicines, drugs, medical appliances and insulin, urine testing materials, syringes and needles used by diabetics.

WHEREAS, the County of Randolph finds itself in financial difficulty due to a loss in sales tax revenue from the Dynegy power plant located in Baldwin, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Randolph, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That on the 12th day of August, 2016, a resolution directing that the question of imposing a special county retailers' occupation tax at the rate of 0.75% to provide revenue to be used exclusively for public safety (the "*Proposition*") be certified for submission to the electors of the County will be filed in the office of the County clerk and deposited in the official files and records of the office.

Section 2. That at the general election to be held on the 8th day of November, 2016, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. (the "*Election*"), there shall be submitted to the voters of the County the following proposition:

"To pay for public safety purposes, shall Randolph County be authorized to impose an increase on its share of local sales taxes by 0.75%? This would mean that a consumer would pay an additional 75 cents in sales tax for every \$100 of tangible personal property bought at retail."

Section 3. The above Public Safety Tax shall be effective with those purchases taking place on or after January 1, 2017.



WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Randolph on this 18th day of November, 2016 has levied One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000) for Social Security Fund for the purpose of above stated funds for the year 2016, which sum will be collectible in the year 2017, and

WHEREAS, the entire amount of taxes extended, or which this Board of Commissioners estimates will be extended or received for the year 2016, for the purpose of above stated (purpose in previous paragraph) will be the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000); and

WHEREAS, the aggregate amount of warrants and/or notes issued to or on the date of this Ordinance in anticipation of the collection of taxes collectible for the year 2016 for the purpose of above stated is the amount of Zero Dollars (\$0) and that amount, together with the amount of interest which has accrued to the date of this Ordinance and which the Board of Commissioners estimates hereafter will accrue thereon until paid, will equal in total principal and interest the sum of Zero Dollars (\$0):

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF RANDOLPH, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Treasurer of the County is authorized forthwith to transfer from the Working Cash Fund of the County to the above stated funds the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000) in anticipation of the collection of taxes levied or to be levied for the year 2016 collectible in the year 2017.

SECTION 2: That the amount transferred pursuant to Section 1 hereof together with the aggregate amount of tax anticipation warrants and/or notes heretofore drawn against such taxes set out in Section 1 hereof, the amount of interest accrued to the time of adoption of this Ordinance and the interest which the Board of Commissioners estimates will accrue thereon until paid, and the aggregate amount of such transfers heretofore made in anticipation of the collection of taxes, shall not in any event exceed ninety per cent (90%) of the actual or estimated amount of such taxes extended or to be extended or to be received as set forth in the preamble hereto.

SECTION 3: That the transfer hereby authorized shall be recorded on the books and records of the County as Transfer No. 1, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand dollars (\$150,000) against the tax levy for the year 2016 for the above stated of the County of Randolph, Illinois.

SECTION 4: That, subject to the penalties provided in Illinois Revised Statutes, the working cash fund shall be used only in the manner specified in Illinois Revised Statutes including, particularly, but without limiting other pertinent statutory provision, upon the receipt by the County Treasurer of any taxes, in anticipation of the collection of which money in the working cash fund has been so transferred for disbursement, the fund shall be immediately reimbursed therefrom until the full amount so transferred has been retransferred to the fund. Unless the taxes so received and applied to the reimbursement of the Working Cash Fund, prior to the first day of the eighth month following the month in which due and inpaid real property taxes by law begin to bear interest, are sufficient to effect a complete reimbursement of the fund for any money transferred therefrom in anticipation of collection of taxes, the Working Cash Fund shall be reimbursed for the amount of the deficiency therein from any other revenues accruing to the above stated funds of the County, and the Board of Commissioners shall provide for the immediate reimbursement of the amount of such a deficiency in its next annual appropriation ordinance.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF RANDOLPH, LLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Treasurer of the County is authorized forthwith to transfer from the Working Cash Fund of the County to the above stated funds the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$425,000) in anticipation of the collection of taxes levied or to be levied for the year 2016 collectible in the year 2017.

SECTION 3: That the transfer hereby authorized shall be recorded on the books and records of the County as Transfer No. 1, in the amount of Four Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$425,000) against the tax levy for the year 2016 for the above stated of the County of Randolph, Illinois.

SECTION 4: That, subject to the penalties provided in Illinois Revised Statutes, the working cash fund shall be used only in the manner specified in Illinois Revised Statutes including, particularly, but without limiting other pertinent statutory provision, upon the receipt by the County Treasurer of any taxes, in anticipation of the collection of which money in the working cash fund has been so transferred for disbursement, the fund shall be immediately reimbursed therefrom until the full amount so transferred has been retransferred to the fund. Unless the taxes so received and applied to the reimbursement of the Working Cash Fund, prior to the first day of the eighth month following the month in which due and unpaid real property taxes by law begin to bear interest, are sufficient to effect a complete reimbursement of the fund for any money transferred therefrom in anticipation of collection of taxes, the Working Cash Fund shall be reimbursed for the amount of the deficiency therein from any other revenues accruing to the above stated funds of the County, and the Board of Commissioners shall provide for the immediate reimbursement of the amount of such a deficiency in its next annual appropriation ordinance.
