ORDINANCE NO. 19-6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CIVIL FEES AND CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC ASSESSMENTS TO BE CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT

WHEREAS, Randolph County Ordinance No. 13-19, approved by the County Board on December 20, 2013; 15-07, approved by the County Board on July 2, 2015; 17-15, approved by the County Board on August 11, 2017; and, 17-16, approved by the County Board on August 11, 2017, currently set forth the fees authorized by the County Board to be charged in both civil and criminal cases in Randolph County; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly passed comprehensive legislation in 2018, which completely overhauls the criminal, traffic and civil fee structures in the circuit courts throughout the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the legislations was to consolidate fees into unified schedules for all counties, to realign fees to be constitutional, and to provide for fee waivers for low income individuals; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act, 705 ILCS 105/27.1b, sets out the fees to be charged in all counties in the State of Illinois by the Clerks of the Circuit Court for the filing of pleadings and for other services provided by the Clerk in civil cases; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.1b provides that, unless otherwise specified, the amount of the fees shall be determined by ordinance or resolution of the county board and remitted to the county treasurer to be used for purposes related to the operation of the court system in the county; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, the newly-adopted Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act, 705 ILCS 105/135 et seq., sets out minimum fines to be levied and assessments to be charged in criminal traffic cases by the Clerks of the Circuit Court in all counties in the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, Sections 15-5 through 16-65 of the Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act establish thirteen (13) assessment schedules for various criminal, traffic, conservation and non-traffic offenses, and for each schedule the County's portion of the assessment is specifically listed and

WHEREAS, Section 15-5 through 16-65 break down how the assessment amounts are to be distributed to various County funds, if those funds are in existence; otherwise, the amounts designated for funds that are not in existence are to be placed in the County general fund for purposes related to operation of the court system in the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board for the County of Randolph, Illinois, that all Sections of the Randolph County Code of Ordinances, and any Ordinance passed regarding Circuit Clerk fees are repealed in their entirety and replaced with the following: SEE EXHIBIT "A"

BE IT ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2019.

AN ORDINANCE amending the Randolph County Zoning Code (Chapter 40) to modify existing regulations and create new regulations related to the use of storage containers within the unincorporated areas of Randolph County.

WHEREAS, there are currently no codes regulating the use of a storage container as a single family dwelling unit and;

WHEREAS, storage containers are unnecessarily restricted for use by farmers in agriculturally zoned land and manufacturers in industrial zoned land, and;

WHEREAS, the Randolph County Zoning Board of Appeals unanimously recommended the following text amendments during their hearing on May 14, 2019, so;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF RANDOLPH, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Chapter 40 Zoning Code

Amend SECTION 2-2 SELECTED DEFENITIONS

Storage Containers: It shall be unlawful to locate in the County an accessory use known as a storage container consisting of a railroad or train car or a truck body or shell on any site in the County, unless the site is in a zoned Agricultural or Industrial district. The person-wishing to locate a storage container as described above, shall be required to secure a special use permit as provided by the Zoning Code.

Industrial-grade steel containers used for storage. Also known as freight containers, ISO containers, intermodal containers, shipping containers, high-cube containers, portable storage units, conex boxes or sea cans.

Addition to ARTICLE 5 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR SPECIFIC USES:

Create SECTION 5-12 STORAGE CONTAINER HOMES ON INDIVIDUAL LOTS

A "storage container home" means any fully intact storage container that has been modified for, and is being used, for the purposes of a dwelling. No person shall place any intact storage container on an individual lot for single unit residential purposes except in conformity with the following regulations:

Same Lot Size/Setbacks. A storage container may be placed on an individual lot only if the district's minimum lot size and setback requirements are strictly observed.

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One Per Lot. Only one storage container home shall be placed on an individual lot. Foundation. Every storage container home shall be placed on a permanent foundation as set forth in this ordinance.

Anchors. Anchors capable of withstanding a vertical tension force of four thousand eight hundred (4,800) pounds shall be installed at the corners of storage container home stand or as otherwise necessary for protection against high winds. Every storage container home shall be securely tied down to such anchors.

<u>Aesthetics.</u> Commercial logos and other marks of commercial use shall be covered with siding or paint.

Amend SECTION 4-1.1 PERMITTED USES & SECTION 4-1.2 SPECIAL USES for AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT and SECTION 4-5.2 PERMITTED USES & 4-5.3 SPECIAL USES for INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS:

Remove "Storage Containers" from special uses list to permitted uses list for agricultural and industrial districts.

Amend SECTION 4-2.2 SPECIAL USES for RURAL SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, SECTION 4-3.2 SPECIAL USES for COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, and SECTION 4-1.2 SPECIAL USES for AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT:

Add "Storage Container Homes" to special use lists for R1, R2, and AG districts.

the proposed variance is the minimum deviation from such requirements that will alleviate the difficulties/hardship, and allow a reasonable return on the property; and

the plight of the applicant is due to circumstances not of his own making; and

the circumstances engendering the variance request are peculiar and not applicable to other property within the district and, therefore, that a variance would be a more appropriate remedy than an amendment (re-zoning); and

the variance, if granted, will not alter the essential character of the area where the premises in question are located nor materially frustrate implementation of the County Comprehensive Plan; and

the proposed variance will not result in a lot less than 2 acres in size.

A "small retail establishment" is a specialty designation for commercial enterprises allowed as a special use in agricultural districts (A). No small retail establishment shall be established or conducted except in conformity with the following regulations:

<u>Unrelated Employees</u>. A small retail establishment shall employ not more than one (1) individual who is unrelated to the family residing on the premises.

Floor space. The total area for the small retail establishment shall not exceed 3% of the area of the lot up to six thousand (6,000) square feet.

<u>Nuisances.</u> A small retail establishment shall not generate any offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat, glare or electrical interference noticeable at or beyond the boundary lines of the lot.

<u>Parking.</u> Every small retail establishment shall provide two (2) off-street parking spaces in addition to the usual requirements for the dwelling id one exists (see Sec. 6-6). Said parking spaces shall be located on the same lot as the small retail establishment.

Amend SECTION 4-1.2 SPECIAL USES for AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT:

Add "Small Retail" to special uses list for agriculture district.

WHEREAS, after consultation with the Supervisor of Assessments, it is the belief of the County Board of Randolph County the division of the County of Randolph into four (4) assessment districts, as provided in 35 ILCS 200/9-225, will allow for a more streamline and effective assessment of the properties subject to assessment in the County of Randolph;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Randolph County Board of Commissioners that beginning with the 2020 assessment year, Randolph County will be divided into four assessment districts as set forth in Exhibit "A"; Color map displaying districts as set forth in Exhibit "B".



WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shalladminister the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Randolph County Board, in regular session, this 18th day of October, 2019 does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorney of this County in the appeal of all cases when requested to do so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney, prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act, and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the trial and appeal of tax objections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor will offer Continuing Legal Education training programs to the State's Attorneys and Assistant State's Attorneys.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor may also assist the State's Attorney of this County in the discharge of the State's Attorney's duties in the prosecution and trial of other cases, and may act as Special Prosecutor if duly appointed to do so by a court having jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor is duly appointed to act as a Special Prosecutor in this County by a court having jurisdiction, this County will provide reasonable and necessary clerical and administrative support and victim-witness coordination on an as-needed basis and will also cover all reasonable and necessary case expenses such as expert witness fees, transcripts, evidence presentation, documents, lodgings, and all other expenses directly related to the prosecution of the case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Randolph County Board hereby agrees to participate in the service program of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, commencing December 1, 2019 and ending November 30, 2020, by hereby appropriating the sum of \$15,000.00 as consideration for the express purpose of providing a portion of the funds required for financing the operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and agrees to deliver the same to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor on request during the stated twelve month period.

CANNABIS ORDINANCE

The following ordinance was presented for approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 19-16

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CANNABIS BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, County of Randolph, a body politic and corporate of the state of Illinois ("Randolph County") is a non-home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, § 8 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, Public Act 101-0027, which provides that the County has the authority to enact ordinances to prohibit or significantly limit a cannabis business establishment's location; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that the operation of cannabis business establishments would present adverse impacts upon the health, safety and welfare of the residents, and additional costs, burdens and impacts upon law enforcement and regulatory operations of the County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF RANDOLPH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Cannabis Business Establishments Prohibited. Chapter 40 of the County Code of the County of Randolph shall be amended by the addition of Article XI, Section 40-11 that will read as follows:

ARTICLE XI/CHAPTER 40/SECTION 40-11: Cannabis Business Establishments Prohibited.

1. **Definitions.** The following words and phrases shall, for the purposes of this Article XI, Section 40-11, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by this section, as follows:

ADULT-USE CANNABIS BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT: A cultivation center, craft grower, processing organization, infuser organization, dispensing organization or transporting organization.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS CRAFT GROWER: A facility operated by an organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture to cultivate, dry, cure and package cannabis and perform other necessary activities to make cannabis available for sale at a dispensing organization or use at a processing organization, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, (P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS CULTIVATION CENTER: A facility operated by an organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture to cultivate, process, transport and perform necessary activities to provide cannabis and cannabis-infused products to licensed cannabis business establishments, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, (P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS DISPENSING ORGANIZATION: A facility operated by an organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to acquire cannabis from licensed cannabis business establishments for the purpose of selling or dispensing cannabis, cannabis-infused products, cannabis seeds, paraphernalia or related supplies to purchasers or to qualified registered medical cannabis patients and caregivers, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act,

November 15, 2019

(P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS INFUSER ORGANIZATION OR INFUSER: A facility operated by an organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture to directly incorporate cannabis or cannabis concentrate into a product formulation to produce a cannabis-infused product, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, (P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS PROCESSING ORGANIZATION OR PROCESSOR: A facility operated by an organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture to either extract constituent chemicals or compounds to produce cannabis concentrate or incorporate cannabis or cannabis concentrate into a product formulation to produce a cannabis product, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, (P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ADULT-USE CANNABIS TRANSPORTING ORGANIZATION OR TRANSPORTER:

An organization or business that is licensed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture to transport cannabis on behalf of a cannabis business establishment or a community college licensed under the Community College Cannabis Vocational Training Pilot Program, per the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act, (P.A.101-0027), as it may be amended from time-to-time, and regulations promulgated thereunder.

PERSON: Any person, firm, corporation, association, club, society or other organization, including any owner, manager, proprietor, employee, volunteer or agent.

2. Cannabis Business Establishments Prohibited. The following Adult-Use Cannabis Business Establishments are prohibited in the County of Randolph. No person shall locate, operate, own, suffer, allow to be operated or aide, abet or assist in the operation within the County of Randolph of any of the following:

Adult-Use Cannabis Craft Grower
Adult-Use Cannabis Cultivation Center
Adult-Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization
Adult-Use Cannabis Infuser Organization or Infuser
Adult-Use Cannabis Processing Organization or Processor
Adult-Use Cannabis Transporting Organization or Transporter

- 3. Public Nuisance Declared. Operation of any prohibited Cannabis Business Establishment within the County in violation of the provisions of this Article is hereby declared a public nuisance and shall be abated pursuant to all available remedies.
- **4. Violations.** Violations of this Article may be enforced in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 40-8-10 of this Zoning Code.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any provision of this Ordinance, is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such occurrence shall not affect other provisions of this Ordinance, or their application, that can be given effect without the unconstitutional or invalid provision or its application. Each unconstitutional or invalid provision, or application of such provision, is severable, unless otherwise provided by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 19-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COUNTY CODE REGARDING THE SALARY OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER

WHEREAS, the Randolph County Board of Commissioners desires to formalize prior adjustments of the level of compensation for the Public Defender.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Commissioners of the County of Randolph that the County Code is hereby amended as follows:

- A. The annual compensation to be paid to the Randolph County Public Defender is
 - An annual salary of \$105,000 is established for the Public Defender.
 - II. Said sum may be adjusted by the Randolph County Board of Commissioners annually, with any changes to take effect on December 1 of any year a change is budgeted/approved by the Randolph County Board of Commissioners.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this revised Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
